

## TOOTING COMMON PLANT RECORDS

This list is primarily concerned with wild plants, no great effort has been made to record species which have been deliberately introduced.

- Acanthus* sp., bear's breech. Triangle Field, thrown out (? or planted) at entrance to Drews Cottages. ARV, July 2009.
- Acer campestre*, field maple. TQ288718. Graveney Woods, several large mature trees; also planted elsewhere. ARV, 2003. **Gall:** *Aceria aceriscampestris*, July 2004.
- Acer platanoides*, Norway maple. Planted beside Tooting Bec Rd. SLBI, det, Tom Maxwell, April 2010.
- Acer pseudoplatanus*, sycamore. ARV, 2003. **Gall:** *Aceria cephaloneus*, July 2004
- Achillea millefolium*, yarrow. ARV, 2003.
- Aegopodium podagraria*, ground elder. ARV, 2003.
- Aesculus carnea*, red horse-chestnut. At edge of, and near Streatham Woods, near junction of Tooting Bec Rd, Garrads Rd, Tooting Bec Gdns and Ambleside Ave; planted. ARV, August 2009.
- Aesculus hippocastanum*, horse-chestnut. Many planted trees; few, mostly short-lived seedlings. ARV, 2003.
- Aira praecox*, early hair-grass. TQ298723. Grassland on south side of Bedford Hill, opposite Bedford Woods. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004 [*Festuca ovina* was searched for in this area, but not found].
- Alliaria petiolata*, garlic mustard. ARV, 2003.
- Allium roseum*, rosy garlic. TQ293725. Near south-east corner of Bedford Field, grassland area disturbed by vehicles in 2003; one plant. ARV, May 2010.
- Allium triquetrum*, three-cornered garlic. TQ289718. Near Athletics Track, beside path running parallel to West Drive; small, non-spreading, patch. ARV, 1994-2009. Apparently slowly increasing in size, April 2010.
- Allium ursinum*, ramsons. TQ293724, south side of Bedford Hill; small patch at base of *Platanus* tree. ARV, 2003.
- Alnus cordata*, Italian alder. Planted, for example in field alongside Emmanuel Rd. ARV, 16 December 2009.
- Alnus glutinosa*, ARV, 2003. **Gall:** *Eriophyes inangulis*, July 2004
- Alopecurus geniculatus*, smaller cat's-tail. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.
- Amaranthus albus*, white amaranth. TQ293722. Lido Field, sports pitch, after reseeding. ARV, 2003. **[BM]**.
- Amaranthus hybridus*, green amaranth - as above. **[BM]**.
- Amelanchier lamarkii*, June berry. One bush in *Ulmus* woodland on east side of Triangle Field. ARV, 11 October 2009.
- Anacamptis pyramidalis*, pyramidal orchid, TQ294723, Clearing in Bedford Woods, one plant. Rodger Evans & Peter White, June 2009 [First seen 2008]
- Anemone nemorosa*, wood anemone. TQ294723. Clearing in Bedford Woods. ARV, 2003- 2010.
- Anisantha sterilis*, barren brome. Scattered. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.
- Anthriscus sylvestris*, cow parsley. ARV, 2003. Flowering at edge of Streatham Woods, 11 April 2010.
- Antirrhinum majus*, snapdragon. Several mature plants in small clearing in wood behind café, presumably thrown out from gardens in Hillbury Road. ARV, 2 December 2009.
- Arctium lappa*, greater burdock, ARV, 2003.
- Arctium minus*, lesser burdock, ARV, 2003.
- Arabidopsis thaliana*, thale cress. ARV. April 2004.
- Armoracia rusticana*, horse-radish. ARV, August 2004.
- Arrhenatherum elatius*, false oat-grass. Common in rough areas. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.
- Artemisia vulgaris*, mugwort. ARV, 2003.
- Arum maculatum*, lords-and-ladies. ARV, March 2004.

*Avena sativa*, oat. TQ288719. Beside Dr Johnson Avenue car-park. ARV, 2004.

*Ballota nigra*, black horehound. ARV, 2008.

*Bellis perennis*, daisy. ARV, 2003.

*Beta vulgaris* ssp. *cicla*, foliage beet. Several plants on disturbed soil beside Garrads Rd, near its junction with Bedford Hill. ARV, 11 December 2009.

*Borago officinalis*, borage. Triangle Field, several young plants on disturbed, semi-cultivated ground in front of Drews Cottages. ARV, 11 October 2009.

*Bromus hordeaceus*, soft brome. Scattered. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Capsella bursa-pastoris*, shepherd's-purse. ARV, March 2004.

*Cardamine hirsuta*, hairy bitter-cress. ARV, April 2010.

*Carex pendula*, pendulous sedge. ARV, 2003.

*Carpinus betulus*, hornbeam. TQ296719. Streatham Woods, several fine, mature trees. ARV, 2003.

*Castanea saliva*, sweet chestnut. Triangle Field, one decapitated, and one semi-moribund, tree beside path. ARV, 18 July 2009.

*Centaurea cyanus*, cornflower. Locality as for *Iberis umbellata*. ARV, 2004.

*Centaurea montana*, perennial cornflower, clearing at edge of Streatham Woods, beneath *Crataegus* tree near Bedford Hill railway bridge; ?originally planted. ARV, May 2010.

*Centaurea nigra*, knapweed. ARV, 2003.

*Ceratochloa carinata*, California brome. Infesting all rough areas. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Chamaemelum nobile*, chamomile. TQ287722, large patch, apparently increasing in size, in regularly mown spots area, due to mowing rarely flowers – some flowers produced in November some years, 2003-8; apparently spreading, ARV, 2 December 2009.

*Chamerion angustifolium*, rosebay willowherb. ARV, 2003.

*Chelidonium majus*, greater celandine. Basal rosettes; rarely flowering. ARV. 2004-8.

*Chenopodium polyspermum*, many-seeded goosefoot. Data as for *Amaranthus albus*.

*Cirsium arvense*, creeping thistle. ARV, 2003. **Gall:** *Urophora cardui*, July 2004

*Cirsium vulgare*, spear thistle. ARV, 2003, edge of Streatham Woods, ARV, 13 February 2010.

*Claytonia perfoliata*, springbeauty. TQ294724. Menage area, on sand. ARV, 20 April 2008 [not previously seen locally].

*Clinopodium vulgare*, wild basil. ARV, August 2004.

*Clematis vitalba*, traveller's-joy. ARV, 2003.

*Conium maculatum*, hemlock, ARV, 2003.

*Cornus sericea*, red-osier dogwood. Planted, e.g. near Lake. ARV, 2003.

*Coronopus didymus*, lesser swine cress, ARV, 2003.

*Coronopus squamatus*, swinecress. Disturbed area near Dr Johnson Avenue car-park, one immature plant, ARV, June 2010.

*Corylus avellana*, hazel. TQ294724. Bedford Woods, where probably native, and Streatham Woods (TQ296719), where planted, ARV, 2003. One shrub in Bedford Woods with fully extended catkins, 3 December 2009.

*Cotoneaster* sp., cotoneaster. Streatham Woods, one bush near railway line. ARV, 16 July 2009.

*Crataegus laevigata* 'Paul's Scarlet' wood on south side of Bedford Hill, one tree. ARV, 31 May 2010.

*Crataegus* sp., a hawthorn. First blossoms on tree at edge of Streatham Woods, near Bedford Hill railway bridge, 22 April 2010.

*Crocus* sp./cv. TQ297719. Streatham Woods. ARV, February 2004.

*Cynodon dactylon*, Bermuda grass. TQ293713. North side of Tooting Bec Rd (A214), between junction with Dr Johnson Ave and Lido car-park, large known since late 1990s; doing less well in recent years, ?due to road being salted less frequently. ARV, c.1997-2009. [Specimen in **BM**].

*Cynosurus cristatus*, crested dog's-tail. Scattered. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Cytisus scoparius*, broom. North side of Tooting Bec Road, west of Lido car-park and elsewhere,

presumably planted. ARV, October 2009. **Gall:** *Aceria genistae*, July 2004

*Daucus carota*, wild carrot. ARV, 2003-10.

*Deschampsia cespitosa*, tufted hair-grass. TQ296718. Beside Winter Pond; one or two small clumps; probably introduced. ARV, 2004.

*Dipsacus fullonum*, wild teasel. ARV, July 2004. One or two plants at edge of Reedbed, ARV, June 2010.

*Digitalis purpurea*, foxglove, ARV, June 2004.

*Echium vulgare*, viper's bugloss, mound near Reedbed, ARV, June 2010; also present c. 10 years earlier and presumably in between.

*Elytrigia repens*, common couch. Scattered, SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Epilobium hirsutum*, greater willowherb. ARV, 2003. **Gall:** *Puccinia pulverulenta*, July 2004.

*Erodium cicutarium*, common storks bill, ARV, July 2009

*Erysimum cheiri*, wallflower. ARV, March 2004.

*Euphorbia helioscopia*, sun spurge. ARV, April 2004.

*Euphorbia lathyris*, caper spurge. Semi-cultivated area in front of Drews Cottages; several small seedlings. ARV, 11 September 2009.

*Fagus sylvatica*, beech. Some mature trees, usually unhealthy looking. ARV, 2003.

*Fallopia convolvulus*, black bindweed. Semi-cultivated area in front of Drews Cottages. ARV, 11 September 2009.

*Festuca rubra*, red fescue, possibly ssp. *commutata*. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Fraxinus excelsior*, ash. ARV, 2003. **Gall:** *Aceria fraxinivorus*. ARV, 26 December 2009.

*Fraxinus ornus*, manna ash. Planted, e.g. in café woodland near Bedford Hill, also apparently self-sown beside south side of railway near Emmanuel Road/Triangle Field railway bridge. ARV, July 2009.

*Fumaria* sp., fumitory. Disturbed ground near railway bridge, northwest corner of Triangle Field. ARV, 2008.

*Galanthus nivalis*, snowdrop. ARV, February 2004.

*Galega officinalis*, goat's rue. TQ292721. Defunct reed-bed water purification area near south edge of Lake. ARV, 2003-10.

*Galium aparine*, cleavers. ARV, April 2004.

*Galium verum*, lady's bedstraw. TQ296718. Grassy clearing near Winter Pond; presumably introduced. ARV, 2003.

*Geranium pratense*, meadow cranesbill. Locality as for *Galega officinalis*; presumably planted. ARV, 2003-10.

*Geranium pyrenaicum*, hedge cranesbill. ARV, 2003.

*Geranium robertianum*, herb robert. ARV, 2003.

*Geranium* sp., a geranium. In grass surrounding Furzedown Lodge, from the garden of which it is presumably an escape or throw-out. ARV, April 2010.

*Geum urbanum*, wood avens. ARV, 2003.

*Glechoma hederacea*, ground ivy. ARV, April 2004.

*Gleditsia triacanthos*, honey locust. Planted. ARV, 2003. **Gall:** *Dasineura gelditchiae*, June 2004

*Glyceria fluitans*, floating sweet-grass. TQ296718. Winter Pond. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Hedera helix*, ivy. ARV, 2003.

*Helleborus foetidus*, stinking hellebore. Streatham Woods. Rodger Evans, spring 2008, 2009.

*Hieracium* sp., a hawkweed. Edge of Streatham Woods, near railway line, many plants. ARV, May 2010.

*Holcus lanatus*, Yorkshire fog. Mostly in damper areas. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Hordeum murinum*, wall barley. Widespread in disturbed areas. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Hordeum secalinum*, meadow barley. Bedford Field and Triangle Field, grassy areas. ARV, July 2009.

*Hyacinthoides x massartiana*, hybrid bluebell. ARV, May 2010.

*Hyacinthoides nonscripta*, bluebell. Scattered in woodlands; some white and some pink flowered

forms. ARV, April 2010.

*Hyacinthus orientalis*, hyacinth. ARV, March 2004.

*Hydrocotyle ranunculoides*. TQ294721. Ecology Pond, one small, short-lived plant. ARV, February 2004.

*Iberis umbellatus*, candytuft. TQ293725. Near south-east corner of Bedford Field, small area in grassland, disturbed by vehicles in 2003, one tiny plant. ARV, 2004. Not persisting,.

*Ilex aquifolium*, holly. ARV, 2003.

*Inula helenium*, elecampane. Bedford Field, unmown grassland towards north corner; one plant. ARV, September 2009; two plants, ARV, May 2010.

*Iris foetidissima*, stinking iris. ARV, 2004.

*Iris pseudacorus*, yellow iris. Introduced. ARV, 2004.

*Jasminum* sp., a jasmine. Spreading from garden in Hillbury Rd. ARV, December 2009.

*Laburnum anagyroides*, laburnum. Planted. ARV, 2003.

*Lactuca saligna*, least lettuce. ARV, August 2004.

*Lamiastrum galeobdolon* ssp. *montanum*. TQ292724. Woodland behind the cafe; presumably grown from material thrown out from gardens in Hillbury Rd. ARV, 16 December 2009.

*Lamium album*, white deadnettle. ARV, January 2009.

*Lamium maculatum*, spotted deadnettle. Triangle Field, thrown out (? or planted) near entrance to Drews Cottages. ARV, April 2009.

*Lamium purpureum*, red deadnettle. Near junction of Tooting Bec Road with Dr Johnson Avenue; some plants with normal coloured flowers and some with white flowers. ARV, April 2010.

*Lapsana communis*, nipplewort. ARV, 2003.

*Lathyrus latifolius*, broad-leaved everlasting-pea. Reedbed (formerly Ecology Pond), on former island, ARV, June 2010.

*Lathyrus nissolia*, grass vetchling. Locality as for *Iberis umbellatus*; persistent and spreading. ARV, 2004-10; first flowers noted 4 June 2010; abundant and vigorously spreading. Also small patch near clump of large lime trees near south end of Lake, ARV, June 2010.

*Lathyrus odoratus*, sweetpea. Locality as for *Iberis umbellatus*; one stunted plant, ARV, 2004.

Not persisting.

*Laurus nobilis*, bay. Spreading through fence from garden in Culverden Rd. ARV, December 2009; sapling in Graveney Woods, April 2010.

*Leersia oryzoides*, cut-grass. TQ296718. Winter Pond; presumably planted. ARV, 2004.

*Lemna minor*, common duckweed. ARV, May 2004.

*Leontodon autumnalis*, autumn hawk bit. ARV, September 2009.

*Ligustrum ovalifolium*, garden privet. ARV, March 2004.

*Ligustrum vulgare*, privet. TQ292727. Railway embankment, several shrubs. ARV, March 2004.

*Limnanthes douglasii*, meadow-foam. Locality as for *Iberis umbellatus*. ARV, 2004. Not persisting.

*Linaria purpurea*, purple toadflax. TQ294723. Bedford Woods, clearing. ARV, August 2004.

*Linaria vulgaris*, common toadflax. ARV, May 2004.

*Lolium perenne*, perennial rye-grass. Common. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Lonicera periclymenum*, honeysuckle. ARV, 2003.

*Lonicera xylosteum*, fly honeysuckle. Hedge around Lido, near main entrance. ARV, May 2010.

*Lonicera* sp. Streatham Woods, ARV, 13 February 2010.

*Lotus corniculatus*, bird's-foot trefoil. ARV, July 2005.

*Lotus pedunculatus*, greater bird's-foot trefoil. TQ294721. Ecology Pond. ARV, July 2004.

*Lunaria annua*, honesty. TQ295722. Edge of Streatham Woods. ARV, March 2004.

*Lupinus* sp., lupin. Casual. ARV, July 2004.

*Luzula campestris*, field woodrush. ARV, May 2010.

*Lycopus europaeus*, gipsywort. TQ292721. Edge of Lake. ARV, October 2003.

*Lythrum salicaria*, purple loosestrife. TQ296718. Winter Pond, presumably planted. ARV, 2003.

*Mahonia* sp., an Oregon grape. Streatham Woods, seedlings. ARV, March 2010.

*Malus* sp., an ornamental crab. Planted many years ago. ARV, April 2010.

*Malva moschata*, musk mallow. Single plant at edge of disturbed ground near railway bridge,

northwest corner of Triangle Field. ARV, June 2009

*Malva neglecta*, dwarf mallow. Triangle Field, single plant near Drewstead Rd entrance to Common. ARV, 28 July 2009.

*Malva sylvestris*, common mallow. ARV, 2003. **Gall:** *Puccinia malvacearum*, July 2004.

*Matricaria discoidea*, pine-apple weed. ARV, 2003.

*Medicago arabica*, spotted medick TQ292721. Grassy area at edge of defunct reed-bed water purification area near south edge of Lake. ARV, June 2010.

*Medicago lupulina*, black medick. ARV, 2003-2010.

*Mentha aquatica*, water mint. TQ294721. Ecology Pond; presumably introduced. ARV, 2003; also near Lake reed-bed, ARV, May 2010.

*Mercurialis annua*, annual mercury. ARV, March 2004.

*Muscari neglectum*, common grape-hyacinth. ARV, March 2004.

*Myosotis scorpioides*, water forget-me-not. ARV, May 2004.

*Odontites verna*, red bartsia. ARV, August 2004.

*Oxalis articulata*, pink sorrel. ARV, April 2004.

*Papaver rhoeas*, common poppy. Locality as for *Iberis umbellatus*; one or two tiny plants. ARV, 2004; and elsewhere, ARV, June 2010.

*Papaver somniferum*, opium poppy, red-flowered form. Locality as for *Iberis umbellatus*; one stunted plant, ARV, 2004; one small, mauve-flowered plant in disturbed ground beside Garrads Rd, ARV, June 2010 .

*Parthenocissus inserta*, false Virginia-creeper. Scrambling out of Culverden Rd gardens and climbing on railway bridge. ARV, August 2009.

*Pentaglottis sempervirens*, green alkanet, ARV, April 2004.

*Phalaris arundinacea*, reed canary-grass. TQ292721. Amongst *Phragmites* at edge of Lake. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Phalaris canariensis*, canary grass. TQ292721, Beside path on south side of Lake. ARV, 2004.

*Phragmites australis*, common reed. Planted at edge of Lake, and at edge of Ecology Pond (formerly boating pond, now reed-bed). SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Plantago coronopus*, buck's-horn plantain. Narrow strip along the north side of Tooting Bec Rd, ARV, 2003.

*Plantago lanceolata*, ribwort plantain. ARV, 2003.

*Plantago major*, greater plantain. ARV, 2003.

*Platanus x hybrida*, London plane. Planted, mainly beside roads. ARV, 2003.

*Poa angustifolia*, narrow-leaved meadow-grass. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Poa annua*, annual meadow-grass. Widespread in disturbed areas and woodlands; also a perennial form in the Menage area (TQ294724). SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Poa trivialis*, rough meadow-grass. Widespread and common. SLBI/Tom Cope, 7 June 2004.

*Polygonum aviculare*, knotgrass. ARV, July 2004.

*Polygonum persicaria*, redshank. ARV, 2003.

*Populus alba*, white poplar. TQ285715. South-west corner of Tooting Graveney Common; several fine mature trees (supporting, for this part of London, a rich lichen flora). ARV, January 2009.

*Populus* sp., ARV, 2003. **Galls:** *Pemphigus spyrothecae*, September 2003, *Taphrina populina*, July 2004, *Pemphigus bursarius*, October 2004.

*Potentilla reptans*, creeping cinquefoil. ARV, 2003.

*Prunus avium*, wild cherry. TQ296724. Bedford Woods, several mature and young trees. ARV, 2003.

*Prunus lusitanica*, Portugal laurel. Bedford Woods, one shrub, ? planted. ARV, December 2009.

*Prunus padus*, bird cherry. TQ292724. Bedford Field, a couple, apparently dying [some still thriving, April 2010], ?planted clumps. ARV, 2003; also near junction of Tooting Bec Rd with Garrad's Rd, Ambleside Ave & Tooting Bec Gdns. ARV, April 2010. **Gall:** *Taphrina* sp. ARV, May 2010.

*Prunus spinosa*, blackthorn. Planted in several places. **Gall:** *Taphrina pruni*, pocket plum. ARV,

May 2010.

*Pulicaria dysenterica*, common fleabane. TQ294721. Ecology Pond. ARV, 2003-9.

*Pyracantha* sp., a firethorn. Streatham Woods, seedlings. ARV, March 2010.

*Pyrus* sp., a pear. Planted. ARV, April 2010.

*Quercus cerris*, Turkey oak. Some mature trees and some seedlings. ARV, 2003.

*Quercus ilex*, evergreen oak. Some mature trees, also many seedlings. ARV, 2003.

*Quercus petraea*, sessile oak. Junction of Tooting Bec Rd with Elmbourne Rd, one tree, planted, ARV, June 2010.

*Quercus robur*, pedunculate oak. Many mature trees; few small trees, ARV, 2003. **Galls:**

*pallida*, oak apple, 2003, May 2010; *Andricus aries*, ram's-horn gall, *Andricus quercuscalicis*, knopper gall, 2003-9; *Andricus kollari*, marble gall, *Cynips quercusfolii*, cherry gall, *Neuroterus albipes*, smooth spangle gall, *Neuroterus numismalis*, silk-button gall; *Neuroterus quercusbaccarum*, common spangle gall, September 2003; *Andricus fecundator*, artichoke gall, *Cynips longiventris*, striped pea gall, *Macrodiplosis dryobia*, July 2004; *Andricus lucidus*, hedgehog gall, September 2003, December 2009.

Despite heavy knopper gall infestation, some regeneration from seed, ARV, May 2010.

*Ranunculus acris*, meadow buttercup. ARV, 2003-2010.

*Ranunculus bulbosus*, bulbous buttercup. ARV, May 2004.

*Ranunculus ficaria*, lesser celandine. ARV, 2003.

*Ranunculus lingua*, great spearwort. TQ296718. Winter Pond; presumably introduced. ARV, June 2004.

*Ranunculus repens*, creeping buttercup. ARV, 2003-2010.

*Ranunculus scleratus*, celery-leaved crowfoot. TQ294721. Beside Ecology Pond (now reed bed). ARV, 2003.

*Reseda luteola*, weld. ARV, October 2003.

*Rhinanthus minor*, yellow-rattle. Grassland near Winter Pond, four flowering stalks, ARV, June 2010.

*Robinia pseudacacia*, false acacia. Planted mature trees, also some vigorous seedlings in woodland

behind the cafe and elsewhere. ARV, January 2009.

*Rorippa nasturtium-aquaticum*, watercress. TQ294721. Ecology Pond. ARV, July 2004.

*Rorippa* sp., yellow cress. One plant at edge of path by Triangle Play Area. ARV, August 2009.

*Rosa pimpinellifolia*, burnet rose. Planted in various places, also, possibly wild, in thin woodland border beside railway-line at north end of Bedford Woods (TQ294725). ARV, 2003.

*Rosa* spp./cvs., roses. Planted in various places. ARV, May 2010.

*Rubus fruticosus* agg., bramble. 2003-10.

*Rubus idaeus*, raspberry. TQ294724. Bedford Woods. ARV, 2003-2010.

*Rubus milesianus*, a bramble. 30 August 1903, collected by C.E. Britton. **SLBI**. See D.E. Allen in *Watsonia*, 25: 167, 2004.

*Rumex acetosella*, sheep's sorrel. ARV, 2003.

*Rumex acetosa*, common sorrel. Edge of Streatham Woods. ARV, May 2010.

*Rumex crispus*, curled dock. TQ294725. Bedford Field. Brian Wurzell, 18 July 2004.

*Rumex conglomeratus*, clustered dock - as above.

*Rumex x schulzei* - as above.

*Ruscus aculeatus*, butcher's-broom. TQ291722. West side of Lake; planted. ARV, 2003.

*Salix caprea*, goat willow. ARV, March 2004.

*Salix ?pentandra*, bay willow. ARV, April 2010.

*Salix* spp., willows. Various species, mostly planted, not yet identified. **Gall:** *Aceria tetanothrix*, July 2004

*Sambucus nigra*, elder. ARV, 2003.

*Scilla siberica*, Siberian squill, grass verge between Bedford Woods and Bedford Hill, many scattered plants. ARV, April 2010.

*Solanum nigrum*, black nightshade. ARV, October 2003.  
*Sorbus aria* agg., a white beam. Graveney Woods, many saplings and small trees; also a few larger,  
?planted, trees at the edge of the woodland.  
*Sorbus aucuparia*, rowan. ? Planted. ARV, 2003.  
*Spergularia rubra*, sand spurrey. ARV, June 2004.  
*Stachys sylvatica*, hedge woundwort. ARV, 2003.  
*Stellaria graminea*, lesser stitchwort. Bedford Hill, near bench near north end of Bedford Woods, also in grass at edge of Streatham Woods near Winter Pond, and elsewhere, ARV, June 2010.  
*Stellaria media*, common chickweed. ARV, March 2004.  
*Symphytum orinetale*, white comfrey. TQ289718. Near Athletics Track, beside path running parallel to West Drive. ARV, April 2010; but has been there for over 10 years.

*Tanacetum parthenium*, feverfew. ARV, March 2004.  
*Taxus baccata*, yew. Several small, self-sown trees. ARV, 2003.

*Tilia x europaea*, common lime, ARV, 2003. **Gall:** *Contarinia tiliarum*, ARV, June 2010.

*Ulmus laevis*, European white elm. TQ295729. North-east corner of Triangle Field, beside path south of railway bridge; one fine tree, ? also numerous seedlings. ARV, 2003  
*Urtica dioica*, stinging nettle. ARV, 2003-9. **Galls:** *Dasineura urticae*, *Trioza urticae*, July 2004  
*Urtica urens*, small nettle. Small plants in garden beside Triangle Play Area. ARV, May 2004.  
*Veronica hederifolia*, ivy-leaved speedwell. ARV, March 2004.
